## Week 3 – Telling

**Jesus said I will build my church and the gates of Hades will not prevail against it!**

**Vital values of Cedar Point Knowing, Worshipping, Telling.**

**Matt 28:<sup>18</sup> And Jesus came and spoke to them, saying, “ All authority has been given to Me in heaven and on earth. <sup>19</sup> Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, <sup>20</sup> teaching them to observe all things that I have commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, *even* to the end of the age.” Amen.**

**Let' s talk about the discipleship process. Everyone in the world is a disciple– whether they know it or not. They are either on their way to knowing Jesus, knowing Him more, or rejecting Him for another.**

**We know that in the end of time every knee will bow and every tongue will confess Him as Lord. Until that day it is our job to participate in the making of disciples.**

**Followers of Christ or Pre followers of Christ it is our imperative to reach and teach them all things concerning Christ.**

**Let' s be reminded of what Paul says in**

**1 Cor. 3:<sup>5</sup>What, after all, is Apollos? And what is Paul? Only servants, through whom you came to believe—as the Lord has assigned to each his task. <sup>6</sup>I planted the seed, Apollos watered it, but God made it grow. <sup>7</sup>So neither he who plants nor he who waters is anything, but only God, who makes things grow. <sup>8</sup>The man who plants and the man who waters have one purpose, and each will be rewarded according to his own labor. <sup>9</sup>For we are God's fellow workers; you are God's field, God's building.**

**Jesus said it this way:**

**John 4:<sup>34</sup>"My food," said Jesus, "is to do the will of him who sent me and to finish his work. <sup>35</sup>Do you not say, 'Four months more and then the harvest'? I tell you, open your eyes and look at the fields! They are ripe for harvest. <sup>36</sup>Even now the reaper draws his wages, even now he harvests the crop for eternal life, so that the sower and the reaper may be glad together. <sup>37</sup>Thus the saying 'One sows and another reaps' is true. <sup>38</sup>I sent you to reap what you have not worked for. Others have done the hard work, and you have reaped the benefits of their labor."**

**Our job is to plant or sow seeds – what does this mean?**

**Our job is not to lead someone to Christ – no one comes to Christ but that the Holy Spirit draws them.**

**Practical application for today:**

- 3. Pray for your neighbors/school friends to begin to have interest in Christ.**
